QUESTION.

The above vessel was reported in the Shipping Papers to have sunk after collision near Newcome Knoll, Liverpool Bay, on the 23rd October last. She was subsequently refloated and entered Gladstone Dock on the 18th November.

The Deferred Reports respecting the case were duly forwarded to you on the 22nd ultimo for your information.

It is now observed from a recent Return received from the Board of Trade that the vessel's Official British Registration has been cancelled on account of "Collision".

In the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether she has been condemned as a Constructive Total Loss, or whether it is intended to effect repairs and replace her in commission.

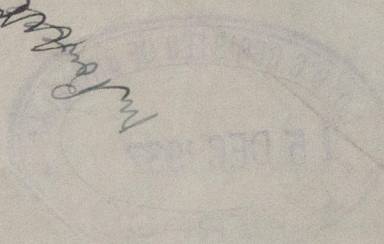

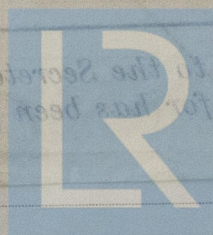
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
