I am a Member of the Institute of Marine Engineers and a Senior Ship and Engineer Surveyor to Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

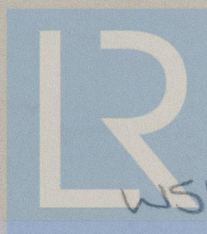
I surveyed the S.S. "ITALIAN PRINCE" for Boiler Survey, alterations and damages at West Hartlepool on various dates between the 8th February and the 9th March 1938. I produce my survey report No.17809

In addition to the information contained in my report I might add that I examined the oil burning arrangements when examining the engines and boilers under working conditions at a basin trial on the 9th March 1938, and found these satisfactory

The valve, on the auxiliary range of steam piping, which supplies steam to the fire extinguishing pipes was opened up, examined, and found satisfactory.

I recommended the engine and boilers of the vessel to be continued as classed in the Register Book with fresh record of survey, which is set out in detail in my report.
