

Frederick George Brooke-Smith will say:

I am a Ship and Engineer Surveyor to Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

I surveyed the s.s. "ITALIAN PRINCE" for Boiler Survey, alterations and damages at West Hartlepool between the 8th February and the 9th March, 1938. I produce my survey report No. 17809.

Apart from the information given on my report there is nothing to add, except that I examined the oil burning arrangements when examining the engines and boilers under working conditions and found these satisfactory.

Steam fire smothering pipes were fitted as required by the present Rules of the Society and were in satisfactory condition. (Omit this paragraph if these were not seen).

I recommended the engines and boilers of the vessel to be continued as classed in the Register Book, with fresh record of survey.
