I beg to acquaint you that the case of the steamer "RISALDAR", referred to in your letter of yesterday's date, was submitted to the Committee at their meeting today.

The circumstances to which you refer were carefully noted, but, having regard to the vessel's age and the wear and tear repairs recommended by the Society's Surveyors at Calcutta in August last, the Committee are unable to agree to her class being retained after the expiration of the year of grace, in May next, unless the Second Special Survey No.3 and all necessary repairs be completed by that time.
