I beg to acknowledge receipt of your classing letter dated the 18th September, 1936.

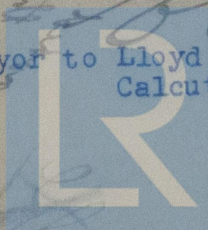
