


Lloyd's Register of Shipping,

Mr. Piddington's survey at that time was confined to Nos. 1 and 5 holds. In his report, his reference to the bulkheads as part examined applies to the bulkheads within these two holds.


He made no examination of the bulkheads of the fuel bunkers or deep tank bulkheads, and those which he did see called for no adverse comment.
