Précis of particulars of Casualty This vessel sustained serious damage by fire in the Philippine Islands on the 13th January, 1937. She was declared a Constructive Total Loss and sold to Japanese purchasers for breaking up.

In the circumstances the Committee decided to expunge her class and make a record of "Damaged by fire 1,37".

On arrival in tow in Japan she was resold and has been repaired.

According to the "Japan Times" forwarded by the Yokohama Surveyors, this motorship has resumed trading.

In accordance with Standing Instructions, the case is again submitted to the Committee in order that the standing casualty record may be altered to "Damaged by fire 1,37 - Now trading".
