Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that according to the publication "Particulars of Japanese Cargo Steamers and Motorvessels 1939" issued by the Nippon Shipping Exchange, the motorship "SILVERCYPRESS" is now owned by the Kawasaki Kisen K.K. and has been renamed "YASUKAWA MARU".

This vessel, which sustained serious damage by fire in the Philippine Islands in January, 1937, was declared a Constructive Total Loss and was sold to Japanese purchasers for breaking up. Accordingly her class was expunged and a record of "Damaged by fire 1,37" was made against her name in the Register Book, all particulars of her being omitted from the following edition.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain and let me know in due course when this vessel has been repaired and has resumed trading. At the same time please furnish me with full details of tonnages, signal letters, official number, port of registry, etc. with a

view to the re-insertion of the vessel's particulars in the Register Book.

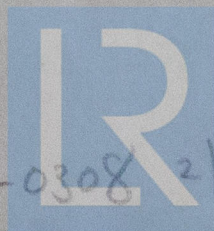
