I have to acknowledge the receipt of your cablegram of the 7th instant respecting the motorship "SILVERCYPRESS", reading as follows :-

"33968 DECLARED C.T.L. LLOYDS AGENTS REQUESTING SEAWORTHY CERTIFICATE PLEASE INSTRUCT".

It was not clear from your cable in what circumstances this request was made, but the facts were explained by the London Salvage Association, with whom I communicated, and I therefore cabled you today as per copy herewith, which is hereby confirmed.

I may add that as, by the nature of the damage, it appeared improbable that the vessel would be able to proceed under her own power, the request was only agreed to on the understanding that the vessel would proceed in tow.


