T.S.S. "INVERCORRIE"

Acting under instructions as conveyed to us from the owner of this vessel, the "INVERCORRIE" was disposed of on May 30th by sinking in deep water about six miles from Aruba.

The vessel had so deteriorated that it was no longer an economical proposition in maintenance or upkeep and the decision was reached to dispose of the vessel by sinking. This being accomplished, we send you herewith the latest Certificates of class for Hull, Engines and Boiler issued at London on April 29th, 1935, together with International Load Line Certificates, original and duplicate, issued by Lloyd's Register of Shipping under authorization of the Government of Venezuela, No. 7771.

We further enclose Anchor and Chain Certificates Nos. 79,2980 and 12044. The anchors and chains of this vessel were salvaged and are now in our possession at San Nicholas, Aruba, and desire that you endorse these Certificates and return them to us.

On account of the S.S. "INVERCORRIE" having been disposed of in the manner referred to above, we assume that you will communicate this information to Lloyd's Register of Shipping at London so that the vessel's name may be expunged from the Register Book.
