Nature of Survey Docking

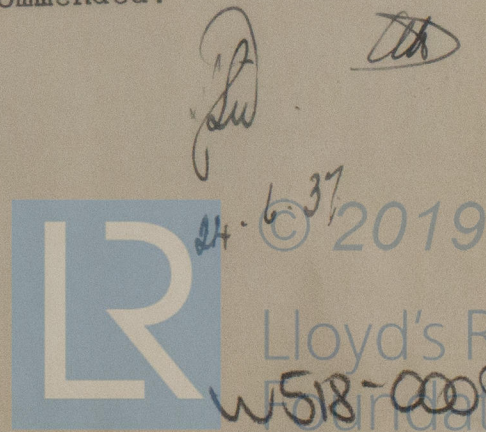
