With reference to my letter of the 21st August last relative to the freeboard of the steamer "ALICIA", I have to acquaint you authorization has now been received from the Government of Venezuela to issue International Loadline Certificates on their behalf in respect of vessels registered in Venezuela.

I accordingly enclose a Venezuelan certificate and copy for this ship for issue when a survey equal to an Annual Survey has been carried out and the lettering of the markings has been altered to agree with the certificate.

At the same time I enclose Venezuelan certificates for the steamers "INVERCORRIE" and "JUANITA" for issue when the Annual Surveys due on the 10th August and 5th July last respectively have been held, also new certificates for the steamer "SURINAM" for issue, no further survey being required in this case in view of your inspection in July.

The certificates previously issued in these cases should be returned for cancellation.

With regard to the Oil Barge "LIMETIA" also registered in Venezuela it is observed that the existing
