The Owners request the new Certificate of Freeboard, which kindly send to this office.

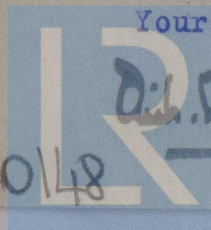
