

Mr. Leslie Farnfield called at this Office today regarding his letter of the 11th instant.

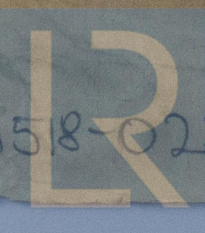

The Society's usual attitude in such cases was explained to him, and he was quite satisfied that it would not be of any advantage to them to subpoena Mr. Collinson in this case.
