We are acting for the Owners of the m.v. "Chagford" which was sunk in collision with the "Black Osprey" in the English Channel on the 24th March last. It becomes material to consider, as it was a fog collision, the speed of the "Chagford" at the time of the accident. We have some information from the Engineers as to how the engines were working and the number of revolutions etc.

We understand that Mr. Collinson of Lloyd's Registry, Hull, was aboard the "Chagford" on her trials on the 12th January 1937, and we should like the opportunity of an interview with this gentleman to see whether he can assist us with his evidence as to the speed which would be developed under conditions which we can give him. If there is any certificate in existence, may we be favoured with a copy on the usual terms. Would you kindly give the matter your urgent attention, as the case is for Trial shortly.
