ANALYTICAL RESULTS

A portion of the oil was diluted and filtered and a fairly large residue was obtained. It consists almost entirely of ordinary earth, though one or two small specks may be rust. No attempt was made to determine the amount, as the sample is probably not representative of the total quantity and the portion analysed was taken from the bottom of the container, to ensure getting the largest possible amount for examination.

The quantity undoubtedly exceeds any B.S. specification for lubricating oil.
