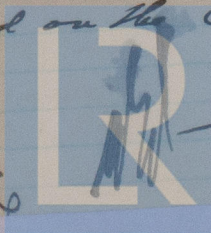


RD REPORT on the

Russian S.S. "Boug" ex "Agnes Duncan."

On enquiry over the phone this a.m. the Cardiff Customs stated the U.S.S.R. have no representative at Cardiff to give permission to issue a freeboard certificate on the Society's run on the authorization of the U.S.S.R. The matter has been taken up ^{with} the Russian Consulate in London through their Transport Department (Temple Bar 5411, even in charge) and they have given their authorization for the issue of a temporary certificate, and will confirm this arrangement by letter. It is submitted certificate be forwarded by the train via Paddington 11.55 a.m. today, addressed to the Cardiff Customs who will meet the train and arrange for delivery of the cert. to Messrs Harris Bros & Co. Ltd. The date of expiry ~~is~~ inserted on the certificate 31/10/34.
