Dear Sir,

We beg to acknowledge the receipt of the freeboard certificates on the s.s. "PYLADES" which have now been handed over to the Owner's Representative.

With reference to your assignment letter of the 17th September, 1932, herewith please find enclosed verification form.

The conditions on the sheet attached to the assignment letter have been carried out as follows:-

- (1) Efficient means of closing have been provided for all ventilator coamings and all airpipes.
- (2) Suitable provision has been made for rigging lifelines in any part of the ship which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working of the ship.
- (3) The bunker hatch on the casing top has a riveted centre division and the hatch covers are only 9'  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " long.
