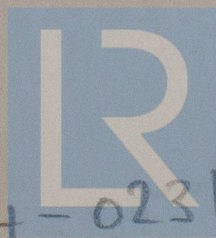
I may say that the Society's Surveyors at these ports have been advised and requested to give the case the necessary attention.
