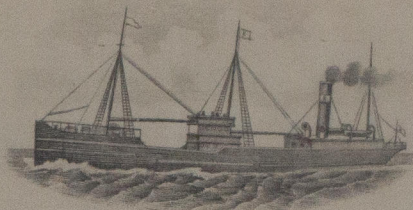

carefully note your remarks.

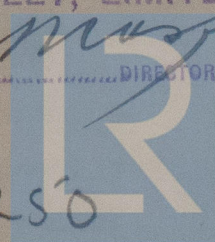
We have already abandoned this vessel to Trinity House,
