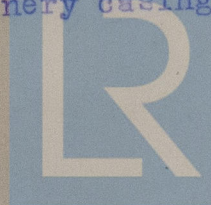

Dear Sir,

With reference to your 'M' letter of the 28th January last assigning Freeboards to the S.S. "FERMANAGH", I have to state that the conditions of assignment attached have been complied with as follows:-

1. The wood fore and afters are now steel shod at all bearing surfaces.
2. Canvas covers have been supplied for closing the air pipes, except those with permanently attached means of closing.
3. A life line has been provided for use in the forward well with means of attachment, port and starboard.
4. The freeing port area in the Raised Quarter Deck bulwarks has been increased to 11 sq. ft. each side by means of increasing the size of the two existing ports and cutting one additional 30" x 18" between them. Steel shutters on steel swivels are now fitted to these freeing ports.
5. The fastenings appliances for the doors in the fore-castle Bulkhead and the exposed machinery casings have now been satisfactorily repaired.
