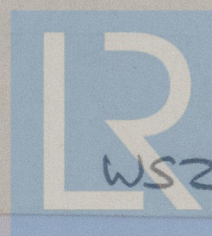
In reply to your letter of 11th inst. re first entry Report n^o 47727 on the S. S. "Grasmere", I beg to state that as this vessel has been built for a special trade on the coast, the owners stated that they were desirous of having four 75 fathom lengths of $1\frac{3}{4}$ wire supplied in place of one 75 length of $8\frac{1}{2}$ Hemp.

In my opinion this was satisfactory, but I regret omitting to submit this deviation from the Rules for the approval of the Committee.
