Particulars of Casualty

The 2nd Special Survey No. 1 became due in July, 1935.

The vessel was sold in September, 1936, to Japanese shipbreakers, and her class was allowed to remain undisturbed until her arrival in the Far East. She is reported to have arrived at Osaka on the 12th January, 1937.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on the 26th February last, when it was decided to expunge the vessel's class and insert a record of "To be broken up".
