With reference to your letter of the 1st ultimo, respecting the case of the new Steamer "NUDDIA" (Glasgow First Entry Report No. 38870), I have to inform you that the proportion of the fees which will be chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of the Hull will be 60% of the difference between the fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees, and in the case of the Machinery, 75% of the difference of the fees, which in this case will amount to say £79 and £75 respectively.

An account has to-day been rendered to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for these fees, and I shall be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books accordingly.
