Fresh water line above centre of disc 5 1/2 ins.

Indian Summer line above centre of disc 4 1/2 ins.

Winter line below centre of disc 4 1/2 ins.

Winter North Atlantic line below centre of disc ins.

Distance between the top of statutory deck line on vessel's side and the intersection of the continuation of upper side of ~~wood or~~ iron deck with the vessel's side (at ~~main, spar or upper~~ dk. 2 ins.
