

S.S. "EARL OF DURHAM" ex "JOLLY CHRISTINE", No. 18537 in the Register Book.

Rule Dimensions:- 125.5' x 21.33' x 10.68'.

This vessel, which was built in 1918 to class with the Bureau Veritas, is at present under survey at Grimsby with a view to class with this Society.

About 18 months ago plans were first submitted to this Office, and a part profile and deck plan was approved, which the Grimsby Surveyors were requested to obtain from the Owners.

The Surveyors now state that this plan has been irrevocably lost, and they consequently ask that the ^{part} sketch profile & deck plan showing the extended hatchway & E. & B. opening dealt with on the 6th January should be amended to include the requirements on the plan now lost.

As no copy of this plan is available in this Office, a few amendments which are considered necessary have been indicated on the present part profile, and this plan should now be returned to the Surveyors, to whom it should be pointed out that in making the survey they should pay special attention to the points mentioned in the Secretary's letter of the 5th July 1926 addressed to the Sunderland Surveyors, a copy of which was sent to them last week.
