I have to acknowledge the receipt of Mr. Palmer's letter of the 5th instant forwarding a sketch of part profile and deck showing a proposal to increase the length of No.2 hatchway and to increase the length of the boiler recess, in the steamer "EARL OF DURHAM" ex "Jolly Christine", together with a plan of midship section approved in July 1926.
