A letter has now been received from the Grimsby

Surveyors enclosing a sketch of part profile and deck, showing
a proposal to increase the length of No.2 hatchway and to
increase the length of the boiler recess, together with a plan
of midship section which was approved by the Committee in
July 1926.

It is submitted that a copy of the letter addressed
to the Sunderland Surveyors on the 5th July, 1926, be forwarded
to the Grimsby Surveyors for their information and guidance in
carrying out the survey.

The Surveyors should be informed that at the same time
as the plan of midship section was dealt with a part profile
and deck plan was also approved, and ~~they should obtain~~ *should be obtained*
sketch from the Owners.

The Surveyors might also be informed that the plan
of proposed alterations could be approved as submitted.
