Boiler pressure stated to be 200 lbs per sq. inch.  
The two lengths of main steam pipe 3" bore x 6 w.t. were examined  
and tested hydraulically to 400 lbs per sq. inch and found satisfact-  
ory.

A sample of the material was examined, gauged, and subjected to a  
flattening test, and showed no signs of cracking.

For identification purposes the flanges of the pipes were stamped
