LUNEDA.—Southend, Argyll, Feb. 9.—
Steamer Luneda ashore Ardbeg, Islay.
Crew landed.
Bowmore, Feb. 9.—Fleet-
wood Trawler Luneda was wrecked at
Ardbeg at four o'clock this morning.
She is totally submerged at high tide.
Total wreck. All crew saved.
Port Ellen, Feb. 9.—
Steam trawler Luneda, from Fleetwood
for West Coast fishing ground, stranded
off Ardbeg, Islay. Crew landed at Port
Ellen.
Ardor, Feb. 9.—Fleetwood
trawler Luneda was wrecked off the
south coast of Islay in the early hours
of this morning. The Luneda grounded
on rocks about a mile from the shore in
a blinding snowstorm and filled quickly.
Skipper Snape ordered the crew to take
to the lifeboat. They were later picked
up by the small steam lighter Fibroch,
of Glasgow, and landed at Port Ellen.
