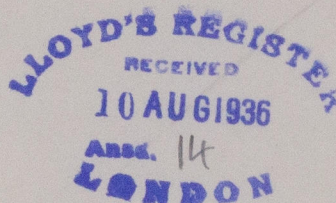

from July, 1936.

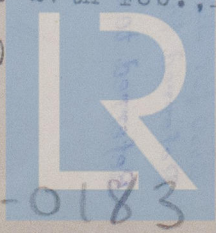
