

Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "SHINYO MARU", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had this case under their consideration in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the 2nd Special Survey No.3 has now expired. It is understood from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe that the vessel is still laid up, and in such cases I would explain that it is the Committee's usual practice to require Owners to furnish an undertaking to carry out all overdue surveys before the vessel again goes into commission.

The Committee conclude you will have no objection to doing so in this instance, and I enclose a printed form of undertaking which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office in due course. A duplicate copy of the form is also enclosed for your filing purposes.
