I have to inform you that Convention ordinary and timber deck cargo freeboards have been computed in the case of the s.s. "STURE" on the basis of the information supplied in Gothenburg freeboard report C.11 No. 9235, which is returned herewith together with the computations.

At the same time I enclose the Convention certificate for this ship in triplicate.

I have to add that the ordinary cargo freeboards as computed under the Convention are not so favourable as the existing freeboards and it is therefore concluded that the Owners will desire the latter freeboards, and the certificate has been prepared accordingly.
