With reference to your report No. 5320 on the  
board of the S.S. "STURE", I send herewith the usual printed  
orders setting forth the freeboards which have been assigned  
to this vessel.

At the same time I have to acknowledge the receipt  
of your cablegram, which being decoded reads as follows:-

"Sture length 121.95 breadth 22.50 depth 11.41 under  
deck tons 244 Stop Wire freeboard".

In compliance with the request contained therein I have  
dispatched the following cablegram to you this morning, namely:-


- STURE = Vessel's name
- ALHNO) = The freeboard assigned is 1'-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from top of  
ALJOS) statutory deck line to centre of disc.
- ALLHY = The statutory deck line is 1 inch above the  
iron deck at side.
- ALPCI = The other lines should be marked as follow:-  
Fresh Water 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " above centre of disc.
- ALSEZ = Winter 1 inch below centre of disc.
