OVERDUE VESSEL
 ANGLo AUSTRALIAN, London, Apr. 6. The owners of the steamer Anglo Australian state that their agents at Panama, who have been endeavouring to get into touch with the vessel, which left Cardiff on Mar. 8 for British Columbia via the Panama Canal and was reported by radio as passing Fayal on Mar. 14, report by cable to-day: Tuesday afternoon called Anglo Australian at Miami and Puerto Rico Radio unsuccessfully since yesterday morning.


