Apr. 6. - The owners of the steamer
Anglo Australian state that their agents
at Panama, who have been endeavouring
to get into touch with the vessel, which
left Cardiff on Mar. 8 for British
Columbia via the Panama Canal and
was reported by radio as passing Fajal
on Mar. 14, report by radio to-day:
Tuesday afternoon calling Anglo
Australian, with Miami and Puerto
Rico Radio unsuccessfully since
day morning.
