The following is an extract from the official
Log Book of this vessel.

4.6.1938 "At 6.45 p.m. vessel passed a lifebuoy
with no canvas covering but having red
bands on it. Prior to this, at about
3.30 p.m. vessels passed two red and
yellow drums and, on one of them, the
marking "6 cyl" could be seen"

Approximate position at time of sighting the
lifebuoy was 31. 02 N. 43. 52 W.

The above position is close to the route between
the Azores and Panama Canal and, possibly that taken
by the ill-fated "ANGLO-AUSTRALIAN".
