SUBMARINE SURVEY OF S.S. "STEFANOS COSTOMENIS".

I herewith submit my report of survey of the above vessel in Takoradi Harbour.

2. In accordance with instructions from Chief Engineer and Captain of ship, I proceeded to survey the forepeak from collision B.Hd. to stem.

3. On Starboard Side about 10'-0" below W.line and about 15'-0" from stem I found a large indent of plating extending 3'-6" in length and about 3" deep.

There is no visible perforation on starboard side.

4. On Port Side I found a horizontal split in the ship's plating about 4'-0" in length, at a position about 8'-0" below W.line and extending aft from about 14'-0" from the stem.

5. The ship was drawing 21'-0" of water, and she has 21'-0" in her forepeak.

I have given a similar verbal report to the Captain.
