From this it will be seen that although the total weight of the Anchors supplied is in excess of that required by the Rules the weight of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bower is a little less than the 15% Margin provided for by the Footnotes to Table 31. I am of opinion that in view of the total weight of Anchors as supplied the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bower Anchor might be approved in this instance as delivered in the Yard.
