Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 7th instant respecting the completion of the 2nd Survey N° 1 and the renewal of the International Freeboard Certificate of the S/S "VILLE D'ARRAS", I beg to inform you that, having taken the matter up with the Owners, Messrs Nouvelle Cie Havraise Péninsulaire de Navigation, I found that the reasons of the letter addressed by Messrs Worms & Cie, le Havre, to the Society's Surveyors at that port, is that the vessel is at present laid up for an indefinite time and that the Owners intend to sell her.-

With reference to the last paragraph of your above said letter, the Owners state that they are quite prepared to sign the usual letter of undertaking with regard to the completion of the survey being carried out before the vessel is placed again in commission and to advise the prospective buyers of the Society's outstanding requirements in regard to the completion of the survey.-

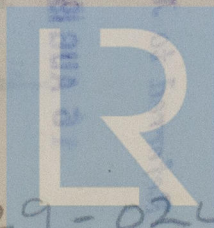
