
Dear Sir,

Reverting to your letters of the 20th January and 25th February last regarding the repairs carried out at Calcutta on the boilers of the steamer "MANIPUR" I beg to enclose a communication from the Owners' Superintendents intimating that the vessel is due at Tilbury on Friday or Saturday next and will proceed to various ports in the United Kingdom, arriving at Middlesbrough about the 14th June, where it is proposed to open up the boilers for examination.

It will be noted that the rivet heads and sample of boiler water are in the hands of Messrs. Goodwin Hamilton & Adamson Ltd., and will be submitted for examination, if required.
