Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your wire as follows,  
viz:- "MIDDLESEX WRITE FULLY TONIGHT HOW CASE STANDS-COMMITTEE PEN"

In reply I have to acquaint you that the Special  
Survey No.1 on the Hull has been completed with the exception of  
the testing of the F.W.tanks.

As regards the machinery, the Engine and Boiler Surveys  
have been held excepting adjustment of safety valves and steam  
trial of machinery. Work in the Engine Room is now approaching  
completion. The new seating for propelling machinery has been  
fitted, gearing and turbines after overhaul and repair at Manchester  
have been installed and put into alignment. The L.P. turbine  
after refitting has been opened up to ensure that no damage had  
occurred in transit from Manchester. H.P. Turbine is yet to open  
up. Auxiliary Machinery re-installed.
