Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Aberdeen have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 14th instant calling attention to the amount of the fee charged by them in connexion with their survey of your Trawler "SHERITON" on the pontoon at that port after stranding in the Orkneys.

In forwarding your application for a reduction in the fee, the Aberdeen Surveyors point out that practically a full day and a half was spent on their inspection, but that in the unusual circumstances, they suggest a fee of £3.3.0 might be accepted in this instance.

This suggestion is concurred in by the Committee, and the Aberdeen Surveyors are accordingly being requested to render you an amended account.


