R. Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "MOORCOT", which has been sold to Japanese shipbreakers for demolition, I have to acquaint you that having submitted the case to the Committee, it has been decided, in all the circumstances, to make a record of "To be broken up" against the vessel's name in the Register Book, and to expunge her class in accordance with the usual practice.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners or their Agents accordingly, and let me know immediately the work of demolition is commenced.

I should add that according to the shipping papers the steamer arrived at Osaka on the 3rd ultimo.
