The following repairs to closing appliances and
protection of openings are recommended, viz:-

- (1) Some side scuttle openings in shelter tween deck,
closed by bolted plates, should be placed in order.
- (2) Some wasted ventilator coamings and air and
sounding pipes should be renewed.
- (3) The top plating of the engine and boiler room
casing, where wasted and holed, should be renewed.
