Gentlemen,

With reference to Mr. McIlvenna's freeboard report No. 6366 on the S.S. "ARANKOLA", I enclose herewith the usual letters giving particulars of the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel, subject to the openings in bulkhead at front of poop and after end of bridge being closed as required by the regulations for full allowance.

I have to point out that as it appears the registered dimensions and under deck tonnage are final, the report has been treated as a final report instead of a preliminary and freeboards assigned accordingly in accordance with the measurements furnished, subject to the poop front and after end of bridge being closed as proposed which you should report in due course when forwarding the verification of marking form, and at the same time furnish a supplementary report giving particulars of the hatchways for attachment to the report now received.
