



Steam Trawler "BOSTONIAN".

This vessel, which was built to class with the Bureau Veritas, is now under Survey at Liverpool with a view to classification with this Society.

The Liverpool Surveyors were instructed that they should endeavour to ascertain whether the steel of which the vessel is built had been tested in accordance with the Society's Rules, and they now forward a copy of a letter from the Builders of the ship - Messrs. Smiths Dock Co. - stating :-

"That the steel material of which this vessel was built was tested in accordance with British Corporation requirements, which are equal to Lloyd's."

It is submitted that this might be considered satisfactory, and the Liverpool Surveyors advised accordingly.
