

Steam Trawler "BOSTANIAN" ex "DRAGON ROUGE"

This vessel was built in 1916 by Messrs. Smiths Dock Co. Ltd., and is ^{now} classed with the Bureau Veritas.

The new Owners, The Boston Deep Sea Fishing & Ice Co. Ltd., are desirous of classing the vessel with this Society.

Sketches of midship section and profile and deck have been forwarded by the Liverpool Surveyors.

The scantlings and arrangements as indicated on the plans have been compared with the Society's Rules for Trawlers, and are found to be equivalent thereto.

It is submitted that provided the requirements of the Rules for vessels not built under survey be complied with, and a favourable report be received from the Surveyors, the vessel will be eligible to be classed ¹⁰⁰/_A Trawler.

The equipment indicated on the midship section has been compared with the Rule requirements, and it is found that the anchors are as required by the Rules, but that 165 fathoms of 15/16" stud link chain has been supplied instead of 120 fathoms of 1 1/8" chain. The weight of the cable in the ship is 75 cwt, while the weight of the cable required by the Rules is 77 3/4 cwt. *The remainder of the equipment is equivalent to the Rules*

It is submitted the anchors and chains could be

approved for the figure "1", provided an additional 15 fathoms of 15/16" chain be supplied.

The Surveyors should endeavour to ascertain whether the steel of which the vessel is built has been tested in accordance with the Society's Rules, and should compare the equipment on board with the certificates.
