I am favoured with your letter of the 27th instant respecting the Steam Trawler "DRAGON ROUGH" ex "GAVINOCK", which vessel has just been purchased by your goodselves.

In reply thereto I beg to state that the vessel was not built under the inspection of this Society, and has never been classed in the Register Book.

To enable her to be so classed it would be necessary, in the first place, for sketches of midship section, profile, boilers and ~~pump~~ pumping arrangements to be forwarded for consideration and provided these were satisfactory the requirements of the Rules for Trawlers not built under Survey would then have to be complied with.

The fees chargeable for the classification of hull and machinery would be say £35, plus travelling expenses if any, if the Survey is carried out in this Country.
