THE "RUMORE" INQUIRY

The assessors who sat with Sheriff Wilton at Glasgow to investigate the disappearance of the Glasgow coasting steamer *Rumore* recommended that it should be considered whether vessels such as the *Rumore*, not being by law bound to be fitted with wireless telegraphy, should not all be equipped with wireless telephony. The final word of the recommendation was omitted in the report of the inquiry which appeared in Saturday's issue of LLOYD'S LIST.
